7. Description Of Incident

During the first 3 races of today in the red fleet. I saw riders going to mark 4 without rounding mark 3 to finish. Unsure if there were racing or were in my group. When I came back from racing today. I looked back at the tracking and confirmed that there were racing in my fleet but sailed the wrong course. Rider number 6 sailed the correct course for race 4,5,6 after realising the mistake in race 3 but did not retire. Rider number 22 and 43 sailed the wrong course for race 3,4,5. They realise the mistake on race 6 but did not retire. This is a breach of sportsmanship and rule 2 penalty and potentially a rule 69 too as this is unethical behaviour.
