

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PROPER USE OF "METASAIL" TRACKING DEVICES

- 1) Each device is associated to the specific participant to whom it is given and thus assigned It is important not to exchange them between participants or forget them ashore.
- 2) Devices are already full charged and ready to use. They will switch on and off automatically for regattas. **NO ACTION ON THE DEVICES IS REQUIRED BY THE ATHLETES.**
- 3) **IMPORTANT !!!** The devices must be attached at the bottom mast between the boom vang fitting and the boom , without the use of tape directly on the device to avoid adhesive tape residue on the device. For this purpose you can collect at the secretary the necessaire light plastic bag in wich you can place the device before taping it to the mast. **NO TAPE DIRECTLY ON THE DEVICE**, USE THE DISPOSABLE BAGS TO TAPE IT.
- 4) The devices have sufficient charging autonomy for the entire event. You will bring them back after last day's races. The device must be returned rinsed with fresh water and cleaned as it was received (without traces of adhesive tape)
- 5) The races are available to be seen live and/or deferred on METASAIL's website

SUMMARY DOCUMENT OF REGULATIONS AND CONTRACTUAL RULES ABOUT THE USE OF "METASAIL" TRACKING DEVICES

- 1) The assignee receives the "Metasail" device at the time of registration and, upon withdrawal, he assumes the responsibility of the same until he returns the device at the end of the last race or before, if so required by the Organizing Committee.
- 2) The assignee must use the device according to the instructions received at the time of collection, do not tamper with it in any way or attempt to open it.
- 3) The assignee is responsible for intentional damage or loss of each device to a maximum fee of € 200.00
- 4) In case of failure to return the device to the secretary at the end of the regatta, the assignee may, under his own responsibility and at his own expense, deliver the device to the Organizing Authority within seven days from the end of the event. Once this term has expired, the device will be considered lost
