PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The wind speed was 6 knots and the sea-state was choppy.
- 2. Both boats were sailing downwind towards mark 3P with SGP 221062 clear ahead on starboard tack and 91 was clear astern on port tack.
- 3. 91 sailing faster established an overlap from clear astern to leeward of SGP 221062.
- 4. The lateral distance between the two boats was one hull-length.
- 5. Both boats were on converging courses, with SGP 221062 sailing by the lee and 91 sailing dead downwind.
- 6. SGP 221062 held her course.
- 7. When the lateral distance between both boats was reduced to half a hull-length, contact occurred between SGP 221062's mainsheet and 91's boom.
- 8. There was no damage or injury.
- 9. Neither boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 10, 14

- 1. 91 on port tack failed to keep clear of SGP 221062 on starboard tack, and broke RRS 10.
- 2. 91 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- SGP 221062 the right-of-way boat did not act to avoid contact with 91 when it was reasonably possible and it became clear that 91 was not keeping clear. SGP 221062 broke RRS 14.
- 4. Since SGP 221062 was the right-of way boat and the contact did not cause damage or injury, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(c) for breaking RRS 14.

DECISION

91 is DSQ in race 3.
