FACTS FOUND

- 1. At the conclusion of the 1st DW leg of Race 3, USA 30 entered the zone clear ahead of PUR, JPN and AUS.
- 2. PUR was overlapped and inside JPN, JPN was overlapped and inside AUS.
- 3. PUR passed the mark inside of USA, JPN and AUS, locked rail to rail each colliding with USA's starboard side amidships aft of the shrouds causing some damage to USA.
- 4. The collisions of JPN and AUS drove USA's bow up contacting PUR on the port corner of the boat.
- 5. No boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. PUR, JPN & AUS failed to give USA room at the mark and broke RRS 18.2(b)
- 2. AUS failed to give JPN mark room and broke RRS 18.2(b)
- 3. JPN is exonerated under 64.1
- 4. USA broke RRS 16.1 but is exonerated under RRS 21.
