URLs for Public Information

The International Jury is using a web-based program for the management of protests, communication with parties regarding hearings and the production of decisions. Parties to protests will be notified electronically of the protest filing and scheduled hearing time (via email and/or SMS if you have registered with an email and/or mobile number). This electronic system will allow competitors to move freely about the event until their hearing is set to begin. And at the conclusion of each hearing, all competitors have electronic access to the jury decisions.*

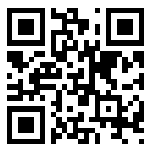
