PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

70 clear astern of 33 Sailing upwind on port tack and at a distance of 15 meters, 14 was on port tack also on sailing upwind and clear ahead of both of them around 15 meters away. 14 tacked and 33 luffed and tacked immediately, 70 luffed and there was contact between 33 and 70 kites and both were tangled. Three minutes later, 70 and 33 recovered and finished the race in the two last places. 14 finished and retired upon retiring ashore. No damage occurred. 33 suffered a minor injury on his leg.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 14, right of way, changed the position of her kite without giving room to 33 to keep clear, breaking rule 16.1.
- 33, right of way, changed the position of her kite without giving room to 70 to keep clear, breaking rule 16.1.
- 33 is exonerated as she was compelled to break a rule by 14 breaking a rule.
- 33's and 70's scores in race F4 were made significantly worse through no fault of their own by a tangled caused by 14 breaking rule of Part 2.
