PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Ben Fels, a member of the jury witnessed the incident and advised the parties and gave evidence as per rule 63.6.
- 2. 'O' flag was displayed before the warning signal of the race.
- 3. 'R' flag was displayed with sound signals at the weather mark as boats on leg 3 approached and rounded the mark.
- 4. On leg 5, HKG2612 was penalised by the on-water jury for pumping on a very congested leg.
- 5. HKG2612 finished the race and then retired on the water to comply with rule P2.2, and then approached the jury that signalled the penalty.
- 6. HKG2612 questioned the jury as to what the penalty was for.
- 7. The jury advised the penalty was for pumping.
- 8. HKG2612 denied they were pumping and asked the jury to identify their spinnaker colour.
- 9. The jury confirmed their spinnaker colour was blue.
- 10. HKG2612 again denied pumping.
- 11. HKG2612 at no time directed the on-water jury's attention to the 'O' flag on the Race Committee Vessel.
- 12. During the hearing HKG2612 testified that they did see the 'O' flag displayed on the Race Committee Vessel. The jury does not accept the testimony of HKG2612 on this point.
