PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. USA entered the zone of a leeward gate mark on starboard preparing for a starboard rounding
- 2. USA was clear ahead of AUS and HKG
- 3. AUS entered the zone on port sailing faster, overlapped inside of HKG sailing slowly on starboard
- 4. As USA rounded the mark and altered to close-hauled, AUS was closest to the mark overlapped inside HKG who was overlapped inside USA
- 5. USA made contact with HKG no damage
- 6. No boats took penalty turns

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. USA was entitled to markroom by AUS and HKG
- 2. AUS was entitled to markroom by HKG
- 3. USA broke RRS 16.1 while she was sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled but is exonerated under RRS 21(b)
- 4. HKG as outside overlapped boat at the zone, failed to give AUS mark-room, breaking RRS 18.2(b)
- 5. HKG as clear astern boat at the zone, failed to give USA mark-room, breaking 18.2(b)
- 6. It was not reasonably possible for USA, [a boat entitled to mark-room], to avoid contact with HKG when it was clear that HKG was not giving mark-room] and did not break RRS 14
- 7. AUS broke RRS 18.2(b) by not giving USA mark-room to which she was entitledbut because she was compelled to do so by HKG's breach, AUS is exonerated under RRS 64.1(a).
