FACTS FOUND

- 1. SWE1727 was sailing on a starboard tack on the first windward beat.
- 2. NED1025 was sailing on port on a collision course with SWE1727.
- 3. NED1025 collided with SWE1727.
- 4. The collision resulted in a hole about 2 inches wide and 4 inches long in the port wing of SWE1727.
- 5. The performance of the boat was affected by the water in the hull that entered through the hole.
- 6. NED1025 retired from race 1.
- 7, SWE1727 raced races 1, 2 and 3 with the damage but about a liter of water had penetrated the bull and the boat's performance was reduced.
