## **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

## **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. FRA 2333 rounded the leeward gate on port tack, clear ahead of ESP 2170, also on port tack, just before the finish in race F6.
- 2. ESP 2170 ran onto the hull of FRA 2333, causing FRA 2333 to capsize.
- 3. The contact resulted in no damage.
- 4. The helm of FRA 2333 got separated from the boat, the crew stayed on the centerboard.
- 5. The helm was taken out of the water by a jury boat after all boats racing rounded the gate and brought back to the boat.
- 6. The crew hurt his back but FRA 2333 finished the race as the last boat, and also sailed the next race without problem.
- 7. ESP 2170 completed a One-Turn Penalty just after the incident.

## **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

- 1. ESP 2170 failed to keep clear of FRA 2333 and broke RRS 12.  $\,$
- 2. By not avoiding contact, ESP 2170 also broke RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for FRA 2333 to avoid contact, therefore she did not break RRS 14.
- 4. ESP 2170 took an appropriate penalty under RRS 44.
- 5. The helm of FRA 2333 was in danger when receiving outside help, therefore FRA 2333 did not break RRS 41.
- 6. The score of FRA 2333 was not made significantly worse by an injury caused by the action of a boat that was breaking a rule of Part 2.
