PROCEDURAL MATTERS

The international jury decided to allow the hearing to proceed.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. At the start of Race 3, Yandoo was judged by one member of the RC to be on the course side at the start signal.
- 2. The signal boat raised Code flag X immediately.
- 3. The PRO had discussion with his team and 22 seconds later made a sound signal.
- 4. Yandoo was scored OCS by the RC.
- 5. Yandoo requested redress on the basis the sound and visual signals were not made in accordance with the rules and that they did not hear the sound signal.
- 6. During the hearing of the request for redress, and based on their own records the Race Committee determined that Yandoo was not on the course side at the start signal.
- 7. The RC stated they would like to reinstate Yandoo.
- 8. Yandoo was reinstated and scored in the position they finished.
- 9. Yandoo withdrew the request for redress.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 62.1

- 1. The race committee made an error in scoring Yandoo OCS.
- 2. FinPort's place in race 3 was not made significantly worse. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1 are not met.
