PROCEDURAL MATTERS

The hearing was heard remotely using Video Conferencing

There were 3 observers.

No Witnesses were called.

Hearing Request 01 held together with Hearing Request 02.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Race 1 3 minutes before the start
- 2. Wind 18-20 Knts with a 1m sea.
- 3. 3821 on starboard was sailing downwind on a converging course with 3365 some 30 seconds before the incident.
- 4. 3821 did not make any hail of Starboard to 3365.
- 5. 3365 on Port was on a windward course converging with 3821.
- 6. 3821 bore away to attempt to avoid 3365 however, there was contact between the Rig on 3821 and the rig on 3365.
- 7. The contact damaged the rig on 3821 such that she had to retire from Race 1 and sailed ashore and did compete any further races today.
- 8. 3365 did take a one turn penalty after the incident but continued to race in Race 1.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 10. 14.

- 1. 3365 on port tack failed to keep clear of 3821 on starboard tack, and broke RRS 10.
- 2. 3365 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. 3365 did take a penalty but this was not appropriate under RRS 44. 1 (b) due to the damage suffered by 3821.
- 4. It was not reasonably possible for 3821 the right-of-way to avoid contact with 3365 when it was clear that 3365 was not keeping clear. 3821 did not break RRS 14.

DECISION

3365 is DSQ in Race 1

Redress is given to 3821 and is awarded average point for races 1,2 & 3 based on races 4,5 & 6 to the nearest tenth of a point. Subject to revision depending on the number of races sailed in the series.
