Notice:

Class rules will not apply.

Boats are given by the OA. While all reasonable steps are taken to equalize the boats, variations will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.

No variation will be admitted by competitors on any part of the hull, appendices, rudders, sails, interiors, rig, or set-up after the boats are assigned to the competitors.

The fairing (smoothing of surfaces) of the hull, rudders and appendices by sanding and/or coating(s), is strictly forbidden. This change CR D2.1

Any deviance from the OA initial set-up will be reported to Int.Jury and the damage deposit will be forfeited. A team can request, only in writing and using the ONB, to the OA to alter the initial set-up and must receive an answer before, in case, to proceed.

Differences with Class Rules are:

CR4.07 = No Flashlight and Searchlight will be given

CR4.10 = No Radar Reflector will be given

CR4.12 = No Safety Equipment Location Chart will be given. The location of principal safety items will be indicated at each boat check-in

CR4.17 = The boat's name will not be on miscellaneous buoyant equipment, such as lifejackets, cushions, lifebuoys, recovery slings, grab bags etc.

CR5.01.1 = Given Lifejacket will not: (a) have crotch/thigh straps (ride up prevention system (RUPS)), (b) have an emergency position indicating light in accordance with either ISO, (c) be clearly marked with the boat's or wearer's, (d) have a sprayhood in accordance with ISO 12402-8
