**Answer:**

Good day Rick,

Sailwave scoring for Series Tie-Breakers is set according to RRS Appendix A8.1/8.2.

The first step in breaking a tie is to list each boat scores from best to worst:

d'Adlib scores 2-2-5

Sahara scores 2-3-4

A8.1 states: At the first point where there is a difference, the tie shall be broken in favour of the boat with the best score. If we eliminate both of the first 2s, the next scores are 2 and 3, which goes in favour of d'Adlib. When 8.1 does not resolve the tie, then we look at the last race score as stated in 8.2. Hope this clarifies the tie-breaking process.
