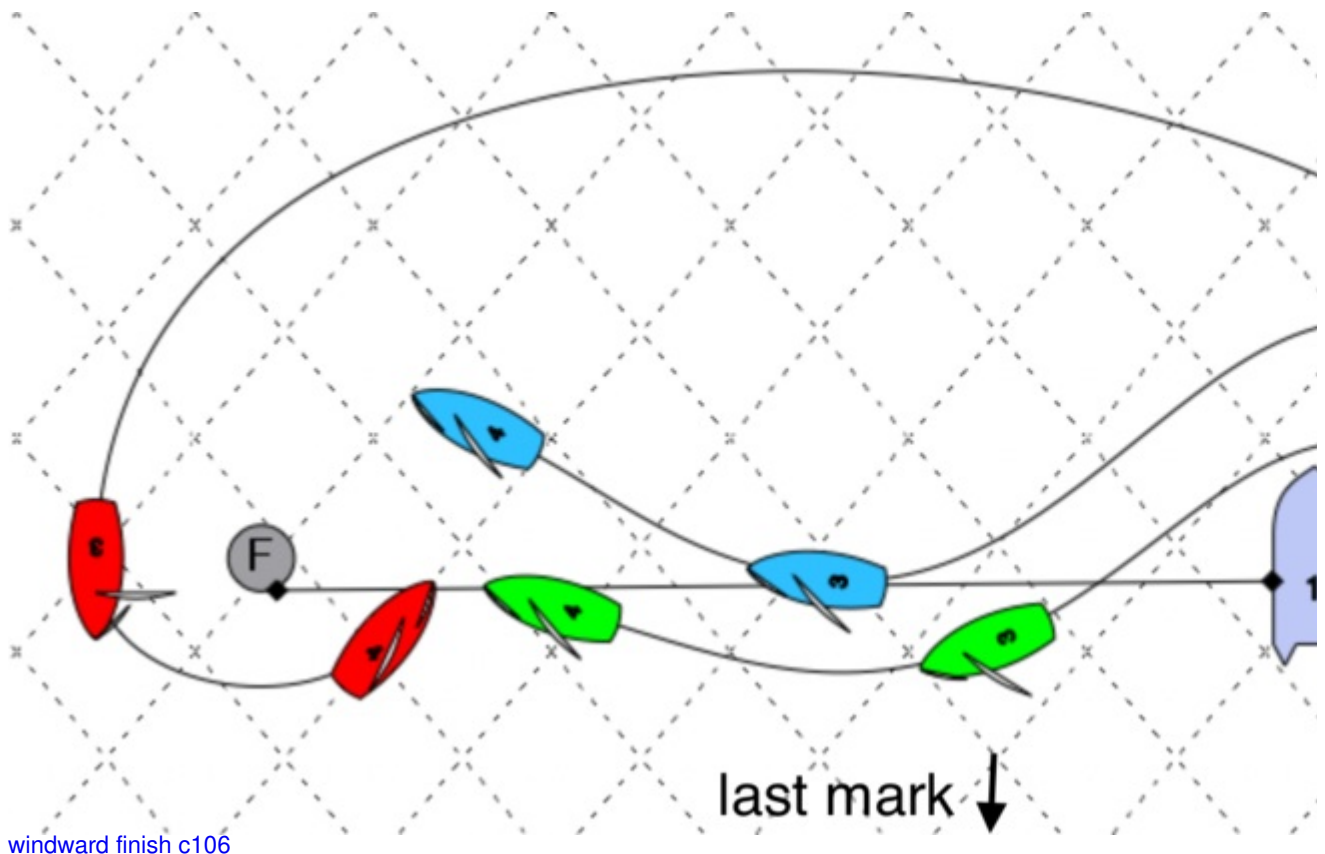
**Question:**

Dear Protest Committee,  
I have a questions regarding case 106 and finishing after sailing beyond the finish line.

**Facts:**

Windward finish. Several boats approaching the finish from well over the lay line. Red rounds the finishing vessel and the finishing mark before crossing the line to finish. Blue rounds the finishing vessel and does not sail with her whole hull on the course side before luffing to cross the finish. Green also rounds the finishing vessel but sails fully towards the course side before luffing to cross the finish.

Question: Which boats have *finished* and *sailed the course* correctly? (see attached diagram)



Question 2: How is a finish line different from sailing through a gate in regards to Definition: *sailing the course* (c)?
