PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

1. 170 meters after the start of race 3, 113 was sailing ahead and to leeward of 20, both kiteboards on starboard.
2. 20 changed position of her kite, contact occurred between the lines and the kites tangled.
3. No kiteboard finished the race and there was no damage.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1. 20, clear astern, did not keep clear of 113, clear ahead, breaking rules 12 and 14
2. It was not reasonably possible for 113 to avoid contact with 20, therefore she did not break rule 14
3. The score of 113 in race 3 was made significantly worse through no fault of her own by a tangle because of the action of 20 that was breaking rules 12 and 14

20 is scored DCT in race 3

113 is given redress and shall be scored in race 3 points equal to the average, rounded to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward), of her points in races 1, 2, 4 and 5. This shall not change the score of the other boats.
