PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind was about $9 \sim 10$ knots and sea-state was choppy.
- 2. THA on starboard and CHN on port were sailing 1st upwind in Race 14 and they were on a converging course.
- 3. Middle of the 1st leg and they were about 2 boat lengths apart, CHN sharply bore away to pass astern of THA and THA held her course.
- 4. Just before passing astern of THA, contact occured between THA's leeward tiller extension and CHN's crew with no damage or injury.
- 5. Neither boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

CHN on port failed to keep clear THA on starboard, and broke RRS 10.

CHN did not avoid contact with THA when it was reasonably possible. Therefore CHN broke RRS 14.

It was not reasonably possible for THA, the right-of-way boat, to avoid contact with CHN when it was clear that CHN was not keeping clear.

Therefore, THA did not break RRS 14.

DECISION

CHN is DSQ in Race 14.
