## **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

## **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. Wind was 8-10 kts.
- 2. CHN, JPN were the first downwind leg sailing on port tack, about 100m from the gate.
- 3. JPN was 3 boat lengths ahead and leeward of CHN.
- 4. JPN gybed onto a converging course about 2 boat lengths from CHN.
- 5. CHN gybed.
- 6. After CHN gybed, JPN luffed and there was contact between CHN's boom and JPN's starboard hull front quarter.
- 7. There was no damage or injury.
- 8. Neither boat took a penalty.

## **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

- 1. JPN, the right-of-way boat, changed her course and failed to give CHN, room to keep clear, and broke RRS 16.1.
- 2. It was possible for JPN to avoid contact, but she did not, and she broke rule 14.
