PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

ESP 11 was sailing to the leeward mark of the inner loop on starboard, inside of FRA 1564 on port. ESP 11 was in third and FRA 1564 in fourth

ESP 11 gybed to windward and ahead of FRA 1564 and contact occurred between her windward side and ESP 11s leeward side.

ESP 11 fell in the water and her sail fell on top of her. She drank water and was suffocated briefly. Her knee was lightly scratched. There was no damage on the boards.

FRA 1564 took a 360 degrees turn penalty and continued sailing.

All other boards rounded the mark.

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{ESP}}\xspace$ 11 got on her board and returned ashore.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

FRA 1564 outside did give room to ESP 11 inside breaking rules 18.2(b) and 14.

FRA 1564 took the appropriate penalty.

ESP 11s place in the race was, through no fault of her own, made significantly worse by a capsize because of the action of a board that broke a rule of part 2.

ESP 11 is scored in race 6 points average of her scores in races 4 and 5.
