First upwind course, 771 on starboard and 883 on port were on a collision course. 771 hailed "starboard" when they close and 883 reduced the boat speed. There was a contact between 883's bow and 771's port wing. 883 did not take penalty turn.

Proper Hail: Protest hailed

Red Flag Displayed: Not required

DECISION: Request Valid

PROCEDURAL MATTERS

1. 883 claimed that he saw 771 take a long time after finishing to report her intention to protest and only after consulting his coach.
2. The RC was contacted to provide information about the time delay between 771 finishing and her report of intention to protest 883.
3. The RC gave the delay as 6 minutes.

FACTS FOUND

1. 771 finished the race and informed the RC about her intention to protest 6 minutes after she finished.
2. 771's protest alleges that a rule was broken while she was racing.

1. 771 failed to comply with SI 14.1 by not informing the RC of her intention to protest as soon as possible.
