PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

1. COL 18 and URU 55 were sailing on starboard, fetching the windward mark. COL 18 sailing high and slow, clear aster and to leeward of URU 55.

- 2. URU 55 entered the zone clear ahead of COL 18.
- 2. URU 55 bore away around mark.
- 3. Contact occurred between the kites of URU 55 and COL 18 $\,$
- 4. There was no damage and no kiteboard took a penalty

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1. COL 18, a kiteboard that reached the zone after URU 55, did not thereafter give mark-room to URU 55, breaking rules 18.2(a)(1) and 14. 2. It was reasonably possible for URU 55 to avoid the contact, but she is exonerated for breaking rule 14 because the contact did not cause damage or injury.
