PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Prior to the start of Race 1, SGP was on starboard and accelerating to the start.
- 1a. The wind was 12 knots and planing condition existed at that time.
- 2. KOR was on port approaching the start and on a converging course with SGP
- 3. SGP hailed "starboard" and held her course but KOR did not respond.
- 4.SGP and KOR collided just after the start.
- 5. SGP hailed "protest".
- 5a. No boards carried out 360degree turn.
- 6. There was no damage or injury.
- 7. Neither SGP nor KOR capsized .

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

1. KOR on port failed to keep clear of SGP on starboard, and broke RRS10

2. It was not reasonably possible for SGP, the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with KOR when it was clear that KOR was not keeping clear and is exonerated under RRS 14(b)
