PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. In race 1, midway on 5th leg between M2 to M3, KOR was ahead and JPN astern.
- 2. When KOR and JPN rounded M2, KOR was about 1.5-2 boat lengths ahead of JPN.
- 3. The wind was 10 knots and surfing conditions existed.
- 4. Initially both boats were snaking downwind.
- 5.. When JPN closed the gap with KOR, both boats stopped snaking. and sailed a straight course.
- 6.JPN surfed forward resulting in JPN's bow catching KOR's mainsheet on the leeward side of KOR and then both hulls remained in contact for a while.
- 7. There was no damage or injury.
- 8. Neither boats did any penalty turns.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. When acquiring right of way, JPN failed to initially give KOR room to keep clear as required by RRS 15 .
- 2. JPN and KOR also broke RRS14 but KOR is exonerated under RRS14(b)
