## **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

## **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. FRA 69 was sailing on port on a broad reach at the finish line.
- 2. MON 60 was sailing on port just behind FRA 69.
- 3. FRA 69 fell (capsized) because he hit a plastic bag after the finish but before she cleared the finish line.
- 4. MON 60 jumped to avoid FRA 69 however MON 60's foil cut several of FRA 69's lines to his kite.
- 5. FRA 69 could not sail race 5 because he was unable to repair his kite in time.

## **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

- 1. It was not reasonably possible for MON 60 to keep clear of FRA 69 as required by RRS 23.1
- 2. It wasn't reasonably possible for MON 60 to avoid contact with FRA 69, as required by RRS 14.
- 3. The damage to the kite of FRA 69 was serious.
