1. Hearing deferred from 1730h to 1800 h as the Jury was still on water.

## **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. IND 210440 on starboard tack and IND 191119 on Port tack were sailing close hauled on a converging course on beat to windward in race No
- 2. IND 210440 was fetching the windward mark No 2. The boats were 2 boat lengths apart when IND 210440 hailed Starboard.
- 3. IND 191119 continued sailing her course. IND 210440 luffed and then tacked to avoid collision.
- 4. No contact took place between the boats.
- 5. No boat undertook any penalty.

## **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

- 1. IND 191119 on port failed to keep clear of IND 210440 on starboard, as required by RRS 10.
- 2. When it was apparent to IND 210440 that IND 191119 was not keeping clear, she was forced to tack to avoid collision. Her action is protected under Case 50.
