## **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. Class 6 is to sail Course 12
- 2. Edenko did not round the windward mark M1A as required in Course 12.
- 3. 2 other boats in that class rounded the mark1A correctly.
- 4. There was a Mark Vessel stationed at M1A to take mark roundings.
