PROCEDURAL MATTERS

1) Parties have had reasonable time to prepare for the hearing.

2) Finishing vessel informed as soon as possible after finishing as per NoR/SI 20.1.

FACTS FOUND

1) The wind speed was approximately 8 knots and the sea-state was choppy.

- 2) 340 and 4462 were sailing towards Mark 1 on a closed-hauled converging course.
- 3) 340 was on starboard tack fetching and overstood the mark slightly and was sailing slightly below close-hauled.
- 4) 4462 was on port tack slightly below the port-tack layline overlapped to leeward and slightly ahead of 4637.
- 5) In the zone of Mark 1, 4637 tacked to starboard followed thereafter by 4462 who luffed and passed head to wind.
- 6) Before 4462 completed her tack, 340 luffed up to a close-hauled course to try and avoid contact with 4462.
- 7) Contact occurred beam-to-beam between the port gunwale of 340 and the starboard gunwale of 4462, with no damage or injury.

8) Neither boats took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

After passing head to wind and before being on a close-hauled course, 4462 failed to keep clear of 340 on a tack, and broke RRS 13. 4462 did not avoid contact and broke RRS 14. It was not reasonably possible for 340, the right-of-way boat, to avoid contact with 4462 when it was clear that 4462 was not keeping clear. Therefore, 340 did not break RRS 14.
