PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. on the 2nd beat to windward, CAN 129 saw only one weather mark and tacked to lay that mark when they were on the port tack layline.
- 2. the weather mark boat placed the offset mark in the water first, then placed mark 1.
- 3. mark 1 was placed in the water after Can 129 was on the port tack layline.for mark 1a
- 4. Can 129 arrived at mark 1 in 3rd position.
- 5, Between mark 1 and 1a, 2 boats passed to leeward of Can 129 $\,$
- 6. after passing the offset mark (1a), Can 129 did a tack and a gybe before continuing on the run.
- 7. the tack and gybe allowed 2 boats to pass Can 129

8. Can 129 finished in 6th position.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

• Setting mark 1 after boats were already on the layline was an improper action of the race committee. Because of an improper action of the race committee CAN 129's score was made worse by two place through no fault of her own.
