PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. US 100 and CAN 123 were sailing to windward on the starboard tack layline with US 100 overlapped 2 boat lengths to leeward of CAN 123.
- 2. CAN 123 bore off and collided with USA 100.
- 3. The collision caused a hole 9" x 4" in the wooden hull about 6" above the waterline.
- 4. CAN 123 did a one turn penalty.
- 5. US 100 finished the race in 22nd place

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- CAN 123 to windward failed to keep clear of US 100 to leeward, breaking RRS 11.
- CAN 123 did not avoid a collision and caused serios damage breaking rule 14.
- It was not reasonably possible for US 100, the right-of-way boat, to avoid contact with CAN 123 when it was clear that CAN 123 was not keeping clear and did not break RRS 14.
- US 100 finishing position was not made significant; y worse.
- CAN 123 was required to retire as per RRS 44.1(b)

CAN 123 DSQ in race 4. Redress not granted
