FACTS FOUND

- 1. 2550 on port (P); 2393 on starboard (S) were approaching the windward mark.
- 2. Both boats were in the zone.
- 3. P luffed, but did cross head to wind, to round the mark and was close to S.
- 4. S luffed to avoid P but it was not possible for her to do so.
- 5. S contacted P and Ps pole snapped.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. NZL 2550 broke rules 10 and 14.
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for NZL 2393 to avoid the contact with P, therefore she did not break rule 14.
