FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind was 8-12 knots.
- 2. IND2 and IND1 both boats on Starboard tack were sailing close hauled on a beat to windward at Mk no 1 in race No 8.
- 3. IND1 was Clear Astern of IND2 and both boats were on the Starboard lay-line, fetching the windward Mark1. One of the Jury Vessels was positioned at 3-4 of their Boat Lengths of them at the mark in clear view of the incident.
- 4. IND2's mainsail and boom brushed Mark 1 while rounding .
- 5. After rounding the Mark1 IND2 hoisted the spinnaker and continued to sail further .
- 6. IND2 did not undertake any penalty immediately after the touching the mark.
