PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Board announced the intention to protest to the RC boat at start at first occasion. ALG-16 was not present at the hearing. The hearing continues under R63.3b.

FACTS FOUND

On the start line at the race 3 the board FRA-1 was moving slowly on starboard tack less than 1 meter from the Committee boat. ALG-16 became overlapped from the leeward to FRA-1 on the course to winward making contact to the winward side of the boom of FRA-1. During the incident the end of the boom of FRA-1 was momentarily in the water

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

FRA-1 as the Winward boat was required to keep clear breaking rule 11. ALG-16, the right of way boat was required to give FRA-1 room to keep clear. She did not do so, breaking rule 16.1. FRA-1 is exonerated for her break of Rule 11, because she was sailing in the room she was entitled.
