PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. USA 51 and RUS 112 were fetching the windward mark to be left on port.
- 2. Kiteboards reached the zone overlapped on starboard tack, with RUS 112 to leeward.
- 3. At the mark, RUS 112 bore away leaving the mark at a distance of three meters.
- 4. In that moment, USA 51 sailed between the mark and RUS 112, creating an overlap to leeward.
- 5. Immediately after the overlap was established, contact occurred between the kites and USA 51 capsized.
- 6. RUS 112 finished the Race. USA 51 did not finish.
- 7. Neither of the kiteboards took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- 1. When USA 51 acquired right of way, she did not initially give room to RUS 112 to keep clear, breaking rule 15 and 14
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for RUS 112 to avoid the contact, therefore she did not break rule 14
