PROCEDURAL MATTERS

1. Parties have had reasonable time to prepare for the hearing.

2. Respondents - 437, 3152, 436 were not present and the hearing proceeded under RRS 63.3(b).

FACTS FOUND

- 1) Opti Silver Race 8 was made under a Black-flag preparatory signal.
- 2) The wind speed was averaging around 6-7 knots and the current was pushing boats across the starting line.
- 3) The RC identified SGP 4424, 437, 3152 and 436 touch the RC signal vessel after the starting signal.
- 4) SGP 4424 took a one-turn penalty approximately 3-4 minutes after touching the RC signal vessel. 437, 3152 and 436 did not take a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

SGP 4424, 437, 3152 and 436 touched a starting mark whilst racing and broke RRS 31. By delaying her penalty turns to 3-4 minutes after the incident, SGP 4424 failed to comply with the requirement of RRS 44.2 to promptly make one turns. Therefore, she did not take the penalty.
