## **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

Protest no 2, 7 and 8 heard together..

#### **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. 1515 rounds mk2 ahead of 1451 followed by 1505 and 1162 to downwind leg.
- 2. After all 4 boats have rounded mark, 1451 hails trailing boats 1505 and 1162 to cover wind of 1515. 1505 and 1162 bear away to sail astern of 1515.
- 3. 1515 bears away to clear her wind. 1505 and 1162 change course to stay astern of 1515.
- 4. 1515 continuing downwind on Run again changes course to avoid cover by 1505 and 1162. 1515 establishes overlap with 1451 to leeward..
- 5. 1451 bears away towards 1515 and makes contact with her. 1515 hails protest. No boat does penalty
- $6.\ 1505$  touched mk3 while rounding it. 1505 does no penalty.

# **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

- 1. 1451 being windward boat failed to keep clear of 1515 the leeward boat and broke rule 11.
- 2. 1451 made contact with 1515 and broke rule 14
- 3. 1505 touched mark and broke rule 31
- 4. Boats 1451, 1505 and 1162 indulged in unfair sailing to give advantage to 1451 over 1515 and broke rule 2

## DECISION

- 1. 1451, 1162 and 1505 DNE in Race no 3.
- 2. 1515 exonerated under rule 14(b)
