## 7. Description Of Incident

Carrera on starbord tack travelling 3.5 knots hailed to Privateer on port tack "Starboard" when the boats were approximately 8 boat lengths apart. Carrera hailed again "starboard" at 4 boats lengths apart which was acknowledged by the other skipper. When it became apparent that there was going to be a collision, Carrera's skipper bore off sharply (45-60 degrees to avoid being T boned. Privateers bow struck carerra 3 inches in front of the aft stanchion. Crew members of Carrera fended off after the collision.

## 8. Damage Or Injury

No injuries were sustained. Carrera suffered deck to hull delaminatiin for about 6 inches just forward of the aft stanchion, damage to he top deck overhang about 8 inches of fiberglass delamination and a thumbnail size hole almost through (maybe 1 layer of fiberglass remaining).
