1. The panel of the International Jury was constituted in accordance with RRS N1.4(b).

2. HKG 171979 was represented by Nicholas Halliday, IND 218191 was represented by Saravanan Vishnu and IND 212161 was represented by Mohit Saini .

3. Although Case 9 was invalid, HKG 171979 - Nicholas Halliday reported there was an allegation of team racing, which is misconduct, the panel decided to consider whether there was a need to call a hearing under RRS 69 or not, in accordance with RRS 69.2(b).

FACTS FOUND

1. Race 6, HKG 171979 finished 25 ~ 30 seconds before IND 218191 and IND 212161.

2. After returning to shore, HKG 171979 informed IND 218191 and IND 212161 of her intention to protest .
