PROCEDURAL MATTERS

1. Darius Gerasimavicius (coach of LTU 2) attended the hearing as translator for LTU2.
2. Alisa Anderson (mother of GBR 4200) attended the hearing as an observer.
3. The panel is constituted according to RRS N1.4(b)

FACTS FOUND

1. In the incident with LTU 2, GBR 4200 had contact with the pin-end.
2. While attached to the pin end, GBR 4200 acknowledged to the RC on the pin end that she will take a one-turn penalty.
3. After getting clear of the pin-end, GBR 4200 took a one-turn penalty.
4. After the one-turn penalty, GBR 4200 hailed 'protest'.
5. There was neither damage or injury.
