FACTS FOUND

- 1. In the incident with LTU 2, GBR 4200 had contact with the pin-end.
- 2. While attached to the pin end, GBR 4200 acknowledged to the RC on the pin end that she will take a one-turn penalty.
- 3. After getting clear of the pin-end, GBR 4200 took a one-turn penalty.
- 4. After the one-turn penalty, GBR 4200 hailed 'protest'.
- 5. There was neither damage or injury.
