PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Under RRS 61.1(c), the hearing#7 is heard together with hearing#1; the PC applied RRS 60.3(a)(2) as, during the hearing of the valid protest#1, learnt that TUR, although not a party to the hearing, was involved in the incident and may have broken a rule - RRS 60.3(a)(2) applies.

The PC informed TUR of its intention to protest as soon as reasonably possible, by posting immediately on the ONB a notice about its intention to protest TUR.

TAMER BASLIG coach of TUR attended the hearing as an observer.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind speed 7 kn, pretty flat water, zone of the 1st windward mark.
- 2. LTU on stb tack was sailing close-hauled on the starboard layline, 2.5 boat lengths from mark 1.
- 3. ESP and TUR on port tack overlapped bow-to-bow, with TUR inside 1 boat length to leeward of the port layline and 2 boat lengths from mark 1.
- 4. ESP was on collision course with LTU.
- 5. When ESP was approximately 1 boat length away from LTU, ESP hailed room to tack to TUR.
- 6. At that time, ESP and TUR were respectively 1.5 and 1 boat length from mark 1.
- 7. TUR held her course and was silent.
- 8. When approximately 0.5 boat length away from ESP, LTU bore away and passed 10 cm. astern of ESP.
- 9. No contact. No boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 10, RRS 20.2(b) and (c), 43.1(a)

- 1. TUR neither tacked as soon as possible nor immediately responded after ESP hailed her for room to tack, as required by RRS 20.2(b) and (c).
- 2. ESP on port failed to keep clear of LTU on starboard, and broke RRS 10.
- 3. Since ESP was compelled to break RRS 10 as a consequence of TUR breaking RRS 20.2(b) and (c), she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(a) for this breach.

See WS Case#3: "A leeward port-tack boat, hailing for room to tack when faced with an oncoming starboard-tack boat, an obstruction, is not required to anticipate that the windward boat will fail to comply with her obligation to tack promptly or

otherwise provide room."
