PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Observers:

HKG 1204 didn't hoist the red flag because they were in the danger of boat collision with HKG 2108.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Wind was very light of 0-1 knot with calm sea.
- 2. HKG1204 and HKD2108 were overlapped and on starboard tack.
- 3. Overlapped was resulted by the windward boat (HKG 1204) overtaking the leeward boat (HKG 2108).
- 4. HKG 1204 and HKG 2108 were sailed in parallel to finish line, around 80 -100 meters away from finish line.
- 5. HKG 2108 was on the leeward to HKG 1204 around 2-3 meters.
- 6. Gap between both boats narrowed down to 1 meter. HKG 2108 took the fenders out to avoid the boat collision.
- 7. The bow of HKG 2108 was pointed to the port quarter of HKG 1204. HKG 1204 switched on the engine, when it was 1 meter away from HKG 2108, to avoid collision.
- 8. HKG 1204 switched off the engine around 1 minute, after getting clear from HKG 2108. HKG 1204 continued to sail and tack to the finish line on port tack.
- 9. HKG 1204 reported their intention of protest to the Finish Boat after the finish line but did not make a detailed declaration about engine usage .
- 10. No boat collision. No boat took any penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 17, 42.3(i), HHYC Standard Sailing Instruction

- 1. HKG 1204 breached RRS 42.3(i) and gained a significant advantage in the race, under the sea condition and wind condition and the position of the boat at that time, but without taking any penalty turns.
- 2. HKG 1204 did not make a detailed declaration about engine usage immediately after the race by notifying Race Office pursant to rule 24 of the HHYC standard sailing instruction.
- 3. HKG 2108 had luffing rights (RRS 17 not applied) because the overlapped was resulted by the windward boat (HKG 1204) action. HKG 2108 didn't break any rule.
