

### EVENT SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (ESIs) (TO BE READ IN CONJUNCTION WITH RS21 STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (RS21SSIs))

#### 1 – RULES

1.1 See RS21SSI Para 1

#### 4 - SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1 When flag AP (Answering Pennant) is displayed ashore, “1 minute” is replaced with “not less than 60 minutes” This changes RS21SSI 4.2

#### 5 - SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1 The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April will be **1400hrs.**

5.3 The RC may broadcast safety and racing information on VHF channel 06.

#### 7 - RACING AREA

The approximate location will be given at the briefing and confirmed by VHF 30 minutes before the first Warning Signal.

#### 8 – COURSE

8.1 The course will be as stated in the RS21SSIs.

#### 9 – MARKS

Course mark 1 & 1a will be Orange inflatable buoys, 2s & 2p will be Black inflatable buoys. If Flag C is displayed at the gate replacement marks for 1 & 1a will be laid which will be Blue inflatable buoys.

The outer limit mark for the start and finish will be Orange.

#### 10 - AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS

#### 22 - OFFICIAL BOATS

Official boats will be identified as follows:

Race Committee Signal Boat: RSrNYC Official Flag

Judge Boats: White Flag with “J” on it

Press Boat: RSrNYC Official Flag

#### 23 - SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered and be identifiable as described in NOS 11.

#### 28 – PRIZE GIVING

28.1 [NP] Prize giving will take place at the venue, when possible after the finish of the last race.

28.2 At least the following prizes will be awarded:

- the top three (3) boats in the event ranking
- the first Corinthian crew in the event ranking
- the first U23 crew in the event ranking.
