FACTS FOUND

- 1. HKG228 was on port tack half way up the beat to the finish line.
- 2. Jury Boat (inflatable Rib) was on-the-water observing per Appendix P.
- 3. HKG228 was on a converging course with Jury Boat who was moving slowly on a downwind heading.
- 4. Jury Boat attempted to avoid HKG228 by increasing her speed.
- 5. However, HKG228 collided with Jury Boat's starboard sponson.
- 6. As HKG228 was luffing in an attempt to avoid contact and eventually colliding with Jury boat, she lost speed for 30sec-1min.
- 7. While HK228 was slowed down, three boats on her leeward and sailing the same leg took over her.
