**MEDAL RACE**  
**Competition document amendments**

For the Medal Races and Medal Series, If there is a conflict between the NOR/SI, STR, CAR, AMR, ER, SP and this notice, this notice takes precedence.

### A. Amendments to Notice of Race (NOR) / Sailing Instructions (SI)

1. Amend NOR 3.1 and SI 4.1 to read:

NOR 3.1 and SI 4.1

Notices to competitors and changes to the SIs or schedule of races will be posted on either:

- (a) The Official Notice Board (ONB) located at:

- (b) The Race Committee starting vessel, after Flag D is displayed and may be communicated orally.

2. Amend SI 4.4 to read:

- 4.4 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with the times in minutes shown below in the Race Signal AP. This changes Race Signal AP.

3. An addition to Addendum A shows Medal Race areas MRA and MRC.

4. Addendum D Marks.

Race Area MRC will use the marks for Area C. Race Area MRA will use the marks for Area A.

5. Notice of Race 6.3 is amended to read:

### B. Amendments to Support Team Regulations (STR)

1. Add STR 1.14 to read:

- 1.14. Support team members on board a support vessel shall be engaged in a function of supporting an athlete as required by STR 1.3.1. Support vessels shall not be used for spectating purposes. For the medal races and medal series for each event only one Support Vessel per participating boat per medal race or medal series race.

### C. Amendments to Competition Area Regulations (CAR)

Amend CAR 2. Field of Play definition to read:

An addition to Addendum A shows Medal Race areas MRA and MRC.

## **D. Amendments to Equipment Regulations (ER)**

1. Amend ER 5 to mark it as [NP] [SP]

2. Amend ER 5.3 to read:

- 5.3 Unless otherwise instructed by the Technical Committee, boats qualified for the Medal Race or Medal Series (including boats that may qualify following a protest or request for redress) shall be in the designated Quarantine Area;
- For the Men's and Women's Dinghy, in the designated area at the boat park on 26<sup>th</sup> September between 1700 and 1800.
  - For Men's & Women's Windsurfing, in the Measurement Hall, soon after racing for the day on 26<sup>th</sup> September but before 1500. Medal Race inspection will be conducted between 1505 and 1600 the same day.
  - Men's Kite, in the designated area in the beach kite venue at 1030 on 27 September.
  - Women's Kite, in the designated area in the beach kite venue at 1100 on 27 September.
  - For IKA Kite only: Post-race inspection - Upon returning after the medal races, competitors have to return to the beach to the designated launch and land zone in front of the pit lane area.

At least one athlete or one support team member shall register the arrival of the equipment in the designated Quarantine Area with the Technical Committee. The following equipment shall also be in the designated Quarantine Area, by the abovementioned deadlines:

- For the Men's and Women's Windsurfing events: maximum of one set (Board, Sail, Mast, Boom & Foils)
- For the Men's and Women's dinghy, boat complete (sail, battens, spars, foils, cordage, tiller, tiller extension, personal equipment (PFD, compass).
- For Men & Women's Kites - Personal equipment, the board and foil ready to sail, the registered kites with the 3 registered numbers visible.

3. Amend ER 5.4 to read:

- 5.4 On the day of the Medal Race or Medal Series the boat's representative shall be in their respective pit lane / quarantine for inspection at the following timings;
- For the Women's dinghy – 0910 to 0920
  - For the Men's dinghy – 1000 to 1010
  - For Men's and Women's Windsurfing – 0910 to 0920
  - For Men's Kite – 1030 to 1040
  - For Women's Kite – 1100 to 1110

4. Amend ER 5.6 to read:

5.6 If a Medal Race or Medal Series is postponed or abandoned, such that the boats return to shore:

- For all events except for Kite events: The boat shall return to and remain in the pitlane area.
- For Kite events: Boards/foils and non-used kites shall be returned to and remain in the pitlane area. Used kites may remain in the launching area.

If a Medal Race or Medal Series is postponed or abandoned for the next day, the procedure outlined in 5.3 and 5.4 shall be repeated.

5. Amend ER 6.1 to read:

6.1 When instructed by the Organising Authority boats shall carry the following as instructed;

- i. Camera mounts with either a camera or dummy,
- ii. Microphones,
- iii. Tracker(s).
