Protests: Si 17 is changed to read

- 1. Protest forms and Hearing requests are available on RRS website.
- The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last board has finished the last race of the day or the race committee signals 'no more racing today';
 Protest Time Limits, Hearing Schedules and Hearing Decisions will be posted on RRS Notice Board
- 3. Hearing schedules to inform competitors will be posted on RRS Notice Board. Hearings will be held in the protest room or in the area designated for arbitration meetings.
- 4. Breaches of WCR 77 and rules in the sailing instructions marked [NP] will not be grounds for a protest by a board. This changes WCR 60.1(a);
- 5. [DP] [NP] Boards retiring from races shall notify the race committee ashore before the protest time limit. Boards taking a voluntary penalty shall complete the Penalty Acknowledgment Form at the jury desk before the end of the protest time limit or the start of an associated hearing, whichever is earlier.
- 6. On the last scheduled day of a competitor's Series, a request for redress based on an protest committee decision shall be delivered no later than 30 minutes after the decision was posted. This changes WCR 62.2.

Equipment substitution, SI 20.23 is changed to read

[DP] Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made through the RRS Notice Board. If at the time of the requested change the acces to RRS Notice Board is limited a member of the race committee should be notified and the form should be filled up at the first reasonable opportunity after racing on the RRS Notice Board.
