NOTICE OF REGATTA OPTIMIST GOLD CUP YACHT CLUB HANNIBAL

14 - 16 July 2021

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

Italian Sailing Federation (FIV) –affiliated Yacht Club Hannibal Monfalcone (Gorizia) - Plana S.r.l. unipersonale (organization YES)

2. PLACE , DATE, PROGRAMME

2.1 The regattas will take place in Monfalcone, Yacht Club Hannibal, from 14th to 16th July.

2.2 July 13, 2021 Coach briefing at 17:30 at Hannibal sailing school.

2.3 July 14, 2021 warning signal at 12:00 hrs.

2.4 For the days following the first day, the warning signal will be communicated by the CoR by 20.00 online at <u>Racing Rules of Sailing</u> and <u>www.yachtclubhannibal.it</u>

2.5 In the absence of a notice, the warning time will be that of the first day of the event.

2.6 No warning signal will be given after 16:30 on Friday 16 July 2021.

3. RULES

3.1 The regatta shall be governed by the Rules as defined in the WS 2021/2024 Racing Rules (RRS).

3.2 The FIV Rules for National Organized Sporting Activity in Italy in force shall be considered Rule.

3.3. Optimist Class Rules to the extent not in conflict with the provisions of this Notice and the Sailing Instructions.

3.4 In the event of any conflict between the latter, the RRS and the subsequent Official Notices shall prevail (Amend RRS 63.7).

3.5 Add to RRS 61.1 (a): "The protesting boat shall inform the Race Committee on the finish line immediately after arriving about the boat(s) it intends to protest."

3.6 RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4 are amended as follows:

3.7.a - RRS 40.1 is deleted and replaced with, "Each competitor shall wear at all times when in the water a personal flotation device (PDF) in accordance with RCO 4.2 (a), except briefly while he/she is changing or adjusting personal clothing or equipment. Diving suits or drysuits are not personal flotation devices."

3.7.b - Add to the preamble to Part 4 after "in racing": "except RRS 40.1 as amended in 3.4.a."

3.8 Appendix "P" of the RRS (Special Procedures for Rule 42) will be in effect.

3.9 The "PROTOCOL FOR REGULATION OF MEASURES TO CONTRAST AND CONTAIN THE DIFFUSION OF COVID-19 IN AFFILIATED SPORTS COMPANIES AND ASSOCIATIONS", current version - hereinafter referred to as the "PROTOCOL".









3.9.1 An infraction of the "Protocol" will result in the application of a [DP] The penalty for an infraction of Point 3.9 "Protocol" may be a minimum of 20% up to disqualification, depending on the seriousness of the infraction.

4. INTERNATIONAL JURY

The decisions of the international jury shall be final as provided in RRS 70.5. at RRS 70.5 and Appendix N. The decisions of the international jury shall be final and the right of appeal shall be denied (RRS 70.5 C).

5. ADVERTISING

Advertising is not permitted except as provided in WS Rule 20. Competitors may be required to display advertising stickers within the rules foreseen in WS Rule 20. The stickers, which will be provided by the Organizing Authority, must be displayed from 2:00 p.m. on July 13 until two hours after the last race.

6. ADMISSIBILITY

6.5 Asindicated in the "Norme per l'Attività Sportiva Nazionale Organizzata in Italia 2021 - Scheda Optimist". 6.6 The Italian competitors shall be in possession of the FIV 2021 card, duly stamped for the part relating to health prescriptions, in good standing with the registration of the Class for the year 2021 and in possession of R.C.T. insurance as provided for and according to the terms fixed by the current FIV Rules for Organized Sports Activities in Italy. The insurance certificate can be replaced by the FIV Plus card. These documents shall be sent to the Secretary of the Organizing Committee.

6.7 There is a maximum number of 480 participants.

7. ENTRY PROCEDURE

7.1. Entry fee is 50€.

- RC insurance with minimum coverage as defined byItalian Sailing Federation regulations for the National Sports Activities Organized in Italy in 2021 (not necessary for those who have FIV Plus card);
- Valid measurement certificate
- Entry form signed by "Supporting Persons / Instructors " who allow minors to submit to the Rules (RRS 3.1(b)) and who, during the event, assume responsibility for getting them on the









water to race and who must accredit themselves by completing the accreditation form that is attached to the entry form.

- Attachment No.3 of Italian Sailing Federation- Covid Self-certification form -measurement of the body temperature
- Italian sailors must send to the Organizing Authority the valid F.I.V. 2021 membership card and the membership of the National Class Association (A.I.C.O.).

7.5 All registered participants are requested to send correctly all the documents indicated in section 8 of this NOR to confirm their registration and allow the Organization to verify the number of registered participants.7.6. After July 12, 2021, any request for event registration will not be accepted.

7.7. The registration fee paid does not correspond to the supply of a good or the provision of a service, but is intended to cover the costs of organizing the race.

7.8 Any profits from the Optimist Gold Cup will be donated to the non-profit organisation 'A.B.C. Associazione per i Bambini Chirurgici del Burlo'. For more information visit <u>https://abcburlo.it/</u> or dedicated page on the website <u>www.yestrieste.com</u>.

8. CANCELLATION AND REFUND

50% of the entry fee paid is refundable for cancellations received by July 5. No registrationfeeisrefundable after July 5.

9. MEASUREMENT CERTIFICATES

All boats must have a valid rating certificate. Competitors shall race with regularly measured boats, sails and equipment and shall not change sails or other equipment without the permission of the Technical Committee or, if this is not appointed, the Race Committee.

10. MEASUREMENT CHECK

There are no preventive measurement checks but checks may be made at the discretion of the Technical Committee or, if not appointed, by the Race Committee and the Protest Committee, during and after the races. All boats shall race with the sail number on the rating certificate. Any changes may be authorized by the Technical Committee only for breakage or damage after verification of the damage by the same Technical Committee or, in its absence by the Race Committee.

11. RACING INSTRUCTIONS

12. RACES AND SCORING

7.1. The Organizing Authority will determine the racing area, further information will be available in the Sailing Instructions. The Low-Point scoring system will be applied to both divisions.









7.2 Division B: The regatta will be sailed by dividing the competitors into heats. Nine (9) races shall be scheduled. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.

7.3 Division A: The race will be run by dividing competitors into heats. At the time of registration, competitors will be divided into groups. Normally during the last day of racing, finals will be held if 4 or more races have been completed. Nine (9) races are scheduled. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of its race scores excluding its worst score.

13. PRIZES

Division A - general classification - from 1° to 3° classified Division A - female classification - from 1st to 3rd place. Division B - general classification - from 1st to 3rd place. Division B - female classification - from 1st to 3rd place.

Among all participants who will be present at the award ceremony, will also be drawn following prizes: 1 Nautivela boat, 5 Giulietti rigs, 10 CD Sails and other special prizes that will be indicated with official notice.

14. CHARTER BOAT

15. RESPONSIBILITIES

It is the responsibility of the parents, team leaders or support person to allow competitors to take part in the races and therefore they must sign the declaration of participation at the time of registration. The Hannibal Yacht Club, the Race Committee, the Jury and all volunteers involved disclaim any liability regarding persons or property, at sea or on land, as a result of participation in the competition. Competitors must have all the necessary insurance to cover any risk, including third parties.

16. RIGHT TO USE THE NAME AND IMAGES

In participating in the regatta, each competitor automatically grants the Organizing Authority and the sponsors of the race the right in perpetuity, to make, use and display, from time to time and at their discretion, any live, recorded or filmed television footage and images and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the regatta in which the competitor is participating and in any and all materials related to the competition without compensation.

17. SUPPORT BOATS AND MOTOR NAVIGATION

Supporting personnel in possession of a boat will have to present the following documents to the Organizing Authority:

- engine registration document (engine brand engine serial numbers);
- engine insurance;
- identity document of the pilot.









All listed documents must be sent to segreteria@yachtclubhannibal.it.The permit will be issued only for assistance in races and training and can be withdrawn at any time if the rules for assistance as stated in the Sailing Instructions are not respected. Support boat must carry a vhf device and it has to be operating when afloat.

18. COACHES, AIDS AND SECURITY

Team leaders/coaches must register with the secretary's office. Team leaders/coaches must adhere to the following:

- Follow all instructions given by the Race Committee and the Organizing Committee.
- Bring additional coaches on board if needed.
- No more than 2 coaches/coaches/parents will be allowed on the same support raft.
- Enter the clubhouse only after checking body temperature.
- Access to boating facilities for Race Committee, athletes, measurers only.
- No access to locker rooms.
- Always wear masks in enclosed spaces.
- Always maintain a social distance of 1 meter.
- The Organizing Authority reserves the right to assign a different zone to each team.
- Follow all the rules published by the Organizer, according to Italian and FIV regulations.

19. MODIFICATION OF THE FORMAT AND TIMES

According to the number of confirmed entries received within the deadline defined above the regatta rules, the Organizing Committee, after consultation with the Race Committee, reserves the absolute right to modify the conditions of the regatta. The official notices of the Organizing Committee, the Race Committee and the Jury will be displayed on the Official Notice Board in front of the Race Office.
