

„If possible protest shall be filed online“

Replace SI 24.8 by:

“Except when participating in rescue operations, support vessels shall stay more than 100 meters from any point where a boat might sail during normal racing and completely outside the area bounded by marks 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 from the time of the preparatory signal for the first fleet to start until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement or abandonment of **all fleets without the intention to start a race soon (orange down)**. When boats are finishing support vessels shall stay more than 100 meters outside and to windward of the starboard end of the finish line until all boats in all fleets have finished. In addition when any boat is racing between mark 5 and the finish support vessels shall remain 100m to windward of the finish line or when coming from mark 4 shall reduce to idle speed when crossing a line directly downwind starting at mark 5 (red zone).”



Replace Fleet System 3.4 by

„Any recalculation of qualifying series ranking after boats have been assigned to final series fleets will not affect the assignments except according to 90.3(c) before the first final race or that a redress decision may promote a boat to a higher fleet.

Different final series fleets need not have completed the same number of final races. The boats in the Gold fleet will be ranked highest, except for a boat penalized in a final series race under RRS 6 or 69.“
