D.9. AUTOPILOT, ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, COMMUNICATIONS

Rule D.9.3.6. « Iridium » is modified to read :

When an Iridium telephone is mandatory aboard, the permanently fixed antenna may be installed, and in this case it shall be fitted to the centreline stanchion between the two pushpits. The Iridium Go is permitted.

Four Category 1 events and according to the relevant NOR for other category races :

- All communications with the outside world are permitted with the exception of communication that may be considered to help a competitor with race strategy, weather routing and/or the reception of weather data.
- No competitor related information concerning a competitor shall be sent to a competitor or a group of competitors except when it comes from the Race Management.
- In the case of a proven breach of this rule, a protest shall be lodged and the Jury shall hold a hearing.
- Except in OSR Category 1 Races the use of the input and output ports of fax and e-fax equipment is not permitted.
- SIM Cards may be sealed before the start of the event.
- Sending and receiving of emails and SMS text messages is permitted.
- Sending emails to any entity is authorised. Receiving emails is only permitted from the Event Organiser's pre-defined email list.
- The reception by email of weather charts is permitted **but competitors wishing to use these charts** shall initially request permission from the Race Director.
- A signed Non-Routed certificate declaring total abstinence of shore-based routing shall be signed by each competitor before the start of the event.

Except because of Force Majeure the Event Organsier shall send to the competitors a minimum of two ranking charts a day.
