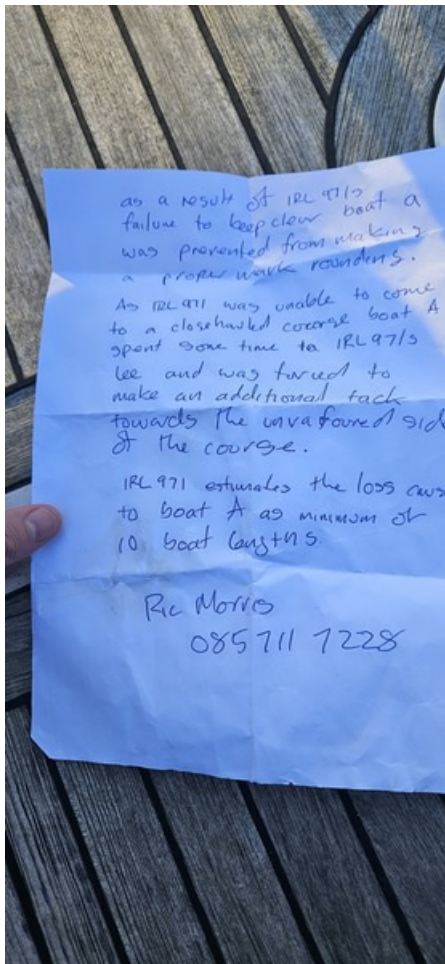
IRL 971 no good notice of her willingness
