7. Description Of Incident

At the start of the race, Toroa was shown to be OCS via the Vakaros system. It accordingly sought to fall behind any non OCS boat. However despite multiple boats being evidently OCS, Toroa was not advised which Boats it should fall behind. No other boats slowed.

Additionally there was a delayed starter being boat 00, that was almost head to wind at the start line. A "delayed starter" call should have been made by the race committee but was not made. Toroa therefore waited for 00 to start and fell behind them, but should not have had to. Toroa seeks redress accordingly. Thank you.

Toroa seeks review of the start via the Vakaros system as well to evidence the boats OCS and that no other boat fell to the back of the fleet to absolve its penalty.
